The Annual Meeting of the congregation and the corporation of the First Presbyterian Church, Pleasant Valley, New York is called for Sunday, January 25, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to hear reports, elect elders, deacons, and trustees and deal with any other business that may properly come before the meeting.



- Pastor Shawn reported on members who are sick. She will be on vacation December 31 through January 6; Arlene Wilhelm will fill the pulpit on January 4.
- 2. Pastor Shawn presented member Ben Sung, who explained to the Session that he feels called to ministry. He has completed seminary and additional courses, and is presently working on his application to Hudson River Presbytery. Session voted unanimously to sponsor Ben in this endeavor.
- 3. Stewardship Committee Chairperson Jerry Conklin reported that as of December 17, 2014, pledges have been received for \$100,394 for local mission and \$18,966 for mission.

 December 20. Session approved
 Debi Tyger's request to donate the
 profits to Presbytery Disaster
 Assistance, the Pleasant Valley

 service as shepherds and angels, and
 the Junior Choir will sing.

- 6. Nominating Committee Chairperson Greg Clark reported that a full slate of officers is ready for presentation at the Annual Meeting on January 25.
- 7. In New Business, Steve Albrecht reported that Brian Rawls of Fabulous Firs donated the trees for the sanctuary and Fellowship Hall. Clerk Marilyn Brands will write a thank you note.


