Dear Friends,

This past week a horrific act took place against a group of worshipers; in a building where sanctuary has been an historic element of their community. Nine innocent people were killed because of the color of their skin. A young Caucasian man, filled with unimaginable hatred, cold bloodedly shot unarmed Americans because they were black.

Unlike other recent problems, among the black and white communities in our country, there can be no equivocation about what actually occurred, or the murderer's intent. He hated black people and intended to ignite a "race war." He wanted to see another "Ferguson," but the families of the innocent victims deprived the shooter of his ultimate goal. They did the unthinkable in this day and age of race baiting and divisiveness — they forgave him.

Forgiveness - a unique concept. These fellow believers actually had the strength of character, not just to forgive such a heinous act, but they unabashedly invoked the name of God. One of the family members told the murderer "God forgives you, and I forgive you." When speaking of the church family, one survivor's voice broke as she stated, "Every fiber in my body hurts. We are the families that love built; we have no room for hate. We have to forgive."

The members of the African Methodist Episcopal Church in Charleston have exemplified what it actually means to say, "I am a Christian." They live it.

Is this not faith that forgives dark deeds Is this not hope that fills a nation's needs


Is this not faith that speaks of highest valor Is this not hope that sheds death's dark pallor


