



THE HISTORY CORNER By Joan Traver

The Pleasant Valley Cemetery

The Pleasant Valley Cemetery was originally the property of the Presbyterian Church. Although the church was organized in 1765, the first building was constructed in 1770. It was a wooden structure, built a bit southwest of the present brick building. The interments were probably made about that time, prior to the Revolutionary War, and located in the vicinity of the building. 5 or 6 additional parcels were added over the vears.

Very little attention was given to this burial ground for more than 100 years. until 1885 when Rev. Prichard was the pastor. Although many more interments had been made during that period, the condition of the cemetery was very poor. There was no walkway, the graves were mounded in form and poison ivy and bushes flourished among the plots. gentleman, whose name is not given in the records, approached Rev. Prichard and offered \$150 toward improvements. Rev. Prichard worked diligently raise additional funds. About \$800, not a small sum in those days, was used to lay out walkways, remove bushes and unnecessary footstones and install fencing. These were great improvements but, as is often the case of many old cemeteries, a gradual decline occurred. The Board of Trustees of the church was technically responsible for the upkeep but funds were limited and other priorities took precedence.

Eventually, it became evident to some plot holders that if progress was to be made in the care of the cemetery, there need would to be a change The incorporation of a management. Cemetery Association was suggested and on April 1, 1899, the pastor, Edgar Beckwith, himself a plot holder, called a meeting to discuss incorporation and a vote was taken in favor. It was also voted that the organization be named the Pleasant Valley Cemetery Association, that there would be 9 trustees, and that an annual meeting would be held to address business.

In 2004, since no further adjoining property was available for expansion, the Association purchased a columbarium at a cost of \$16,000. It contains 64 niches, each accommodating 2 urns.

Board ofThe Trustees ofthe Association remains at 9 members today. Trustees are replaced whenever someone resigns, by whomever is a plot holder and is willing to serve. There are no term There are 3 paid positions: President, Treasurer and Superintendent of Grounds. An annual meeting is held in February. Currently on the Board, and also members of our church, are: Gerald Conklin, Steve Albrecht, Joyce Brower, Donald Traver, Joan Smith and Beth Ricket.

Pastors of our church who are buried in the cemetery are: Wheeler Case, John Clark, Benjamin Wile, Henry Acker, Edgar Beckwith and Robert Agnew.
