Greetings in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ,

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, <u>give thanks in all circumstances</u>; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-19

Lately, we have been talking about expressing thankfulness to God in our daily conversations with our Creator. This scripture from Thessalonians admonishes us to give thanks in all circumstances — meaning the good and the bad. The following anecdote about the Bible commentator Matthew Henry illustrates this point so beautifully. One day while out walking Matthew was waylaid and robbed. That evening he wrote these words in his diary:

Let me be thankful-

first, because I was never robbed before

second, because although they took my wallet they did not take my life *third*, because although they took my all, it was not much, and *fourth*, because I was the one who was robbed, not I who robbed.

How clearly illustrated is the concept of thankfulness in Matthew Henry's diary. Knowing it was his duty before God to be thankful it was from a genuinely thankful heart he penned those words. What an amazing example!

Today we struggle with multitudinous complexities and challenges presented by a post-modern world that offers no reference to deity, but looks for life support from philosophical roots without the necessary depth of soil for human growth. I wonder, where is our gratitude to the God who not only created us, but gave his very blood that we might have an abundant life? Why do we, who call ourselves followers of Christ, rely on society as our source of knowledge and comportment? God and God's laws are cast aside. Instead of Christendom molding to a God who has a clearly provided pathway upon which we are to walk, we now rely on societal "norms" to show us the way. Because we do not read the word or talk to the Word, many of us are adrift in an ungodly world, unwilling or unable to voice gratitude because we no longer hold to the teachings of our Lord. The Bible and the church have become passé and many of us are

unable to discern that which is good from that which is evil. We no longer recognize that for which we owe God gratitude.

The scripture goes on to say in verse 21:

...hold fast to that which is good...

Let us thank our God for the Word made flesh that walked among us, and for the Spirit who willingly guides us, even now






- Pastor Shawn reported on and lead discussion of current issues, church needs and requests.


Sunday School Starts September 13th


