Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ,

Recently, the tenderness of Jesus has engaged my thoughts. Throughout scripture we read of Christ's genuine heart, and the ways in which he ministered to many. Jesus was fully vested in doing the work of Abba, his father, traveling about the ancient rugged world, healing and caring for the sick and bereaved.
