- 1. Pastor Shawn reported on members who are sick. The baptism of Haylie Raine Powers will take place on January 29.
- 2. Clerk Marilyn Brands presented the Statistical Report for General Assembly for 2016, which was approved by Session.
- 3. Session approved the 2017 Budget as presented by the Finance Committee.
- 4. Personnel Committee Chairperson Mary Jane Gardner reported that her committee recommends Linda Morey and Joyce Brower to the position of Secretary/Office Manager. They will be sharing the duties. This was approved by Session.
- 5. Stewardship Committee Chairperson Linda Morey reported that 52 pledges have been received. \$107,692 has been pledged to the Local Budget and \$14,196 has been pledged for Mission, for a total of \$121,888.
- 6. Christian Education Coordinator requested permission to hold a Date Night for parents of young children, hosted by the senior high class, on February 11. This was approved by Session.
- 7. Worship Committee Chairperson Phyllis Menzenski assigned elders to administer Communion on February 5.
- 8. Nominating Chairperson Greg Clark reported that we have an open position on Deacons, and an open position on Trustees. An appeal will be made at the annual congregational meeting to fill these positions.
- 9. In New Business, possible fundraisers for 2017 were discussed.

## **Budget Report from Annual Meeting**

At the annual congregational meeting held on January 22, Treasurer Wayne Sauer reported that our ending balance for the year 2016 was a surplus of \$14,815. After beginning the year with a budget deficit of \$21,046, this was a remarkable accomplishment. The difference is the result of additional giving in 2016: new pledges, increased pledges, and donations beyond pledges. We thank this congregation for their faith-filled financial support for our church. While we are beginning 2017 with a deficit budget, this surplus puts us in a much stronger position than we were in last year.

Several members commented on the increased giving in the budget line "per capita apportionment," which reflects members who paid the fee that is sent to Presbytery for each member on our Active Member roll. This fee of \$34.10 sounds small for one member, but the cost to our church for membership is over \$6,000. For every member who is able to pay their own apportionment, that expense is lessened. There is an envelope in your box of offering envelopes for this purpose.

Per capita apportionment is paid to the Presbytery of Hudson River to cover the costs of Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly operating costs. We thank you for considering a contribution.

## **Adams Gift Card Program**

I am asking each of you to consider supporting our church by participating in the Adams Gift Card Program. This year-long fundraiser requires no extra money and only a few minutes of your time. Simply see Helen Traver or stop by the church office during business hours, to purchase a \$25, \$50 or \$100 Adams gift card. Adams generously gives us additional cards for 10% of our bulk order. We raise our money when you purchase your cards from the church.

There are plenty of things to buy at Adams in February - Valentine's Day flowers and special treats, fresh food, bird food and even snow shovels. I thank you, and the Finance Committee will appreciate the boost to our budget.

### HOMELESS SHELTER MEAL


## PW will be preparing and serving the meal on Tuesday, February 14th.
