### Happy New Year!

If you asked 100 churches what <u>one thing</u> needs to change in their church life, what one improvement would have the most positive impact in their community, 99 of them will offer one particular answer – COMMUNICATION. I think to some extent this is true but I also think that to some extent it is overplayed and might serve as an excuse, a red herring of sorts, that distracts from issues that we would actually much prefer to not talk about.

All of the church's work is communication. We find our primary identity as an outpost of the gospel, a local expression of the body of Christ in our neighborhood and community. Living into this identity means communicating the love of God in Christ – the *gospel* – in a multiplicity of ways. And we need to think about our *communication strategy* so that we can make good decisions about deploying scarce resources – time and talent and financial - in the most effective ways.



The church communicates *internally* in many ways: the weekly worship bulletin, announcements in worship, the monthly newsletter, and the ever-present grapevine. The church communicates *externally* through press releases, advertising, and personal touch, like soliciting auction donations.



Newer modes of communication include email and texting and social media such as Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter. Although many people currently *inside* the church may not participate in many, or any, of these, this is where we will find people *outside* the church to connect to and, potentially, to serve. Our overall church communication strategy has to cover both internal and external audiences as well as traditional and newer media channels. One of my goals for 2019 is to reinstitute the Technology Committee, perhaps as a broader Communication & Technology Committee,

where we can think about these things together, to the glory of God! Might God be calling you to this work? Pray on it and let me know what you hear!


