Financial Summary...



As of May 31, 2012 the General

Operating Fund has collected \$71,027 and expended \$87,310, leaving our Church with a five month deficit of \$16,283. In comparison, the 2010 five month deficit was \$15,800.

A special thank you goes out to everyone for supporting our fund raisers. Our Mayfest produced a profit of \$2,494; our Chicken Barbeque raised \$1,400, and our recent yard sale raised \$140. Let's not forget about the ongoing Adam's gift card sales that have generated \$900 for the Church through May and we project another \$400 in June!

If you recall we all were saying thank God for the mild winter we had this year. This indeed was a blessing as our Church saved over \$3,000 in fuel oil this winter.
