Other activities included Friendship Callers, Session meeting, new member class, Mission Study meetings, Stewardship meeting, and Hudson River Presbytery new pastor orientation.
- 2. Clerk Marilyn Brands reported on the Clerks meeting at Stony Point on April 28. The Session minutes of 2018 were checked and the Stated Clerk was given a copy of our congregational by-laws. The Stated Clerk gave instruction on churches' use of social media; this was shared with Session.
- 3. Pastor Lynn led a wide-ranging discussion of goals for 2019. Two items discussed were leadership development and evaluation and organization of fund raisers. One priority for 2019 will be restructuring and reinvigorating Session committees.


