

## **Session Update**

Pastor Lynn reported on Lenten activities. 11 people participated in the book study, 10 attended the Soup and Bread suppers, and 22 attended Wednesday evening services. In March she attended the Trustees meeting, Mission Study Team meetings, and the March 24 Presbytery meeting. Lynn led a discussion on church issues in preparation for setting 2019 priorities at the next meeting.

Christian Education Committee Chairperson Chesney Baker reported that the committee met on April 3 and planned for the Palm Sunday activities, the Palm Sunday processional and Easter egg hunt. Beth will be looking for volunteers for Vacation Bible School.

Finance Committee members Helen Traver and Gary Murphy reported that pledges are up \$6,467 from last year; the deficit is \$3,228 compared to a deficit of \$15,168 at this time last year.

Stewardship Committee Chairperson Edith Keck reported that the One Great Hour of Sharing offering will be collected on Easter Sunday.

Lynn reported on the Trustees meeting. Sue Morey was present at that meeting to speak about researching the possibility of placing the church on the National Historic Registry.

Technology and Communications Committee member Hope Murphy reported that the church now has an Instagram account, and committee Chairperson James Sawner is posting every day. These posts go to the church's Facebook site.
