Session Update

- 1. Pastor Shawn announced that she is planning to retire in February. Gavin Meek, Interim General Presbyter, and Luanne Panarotti, Committee on Ministry representative, were present to explain the process of finding the next pastor. Pastor Shawn has sent out a letter to members of the congregation to inform them of her decision and her continuing prayers for our congregation. Pastor Shawn reported that Sue Moore has requested a transfer of membership from Caldwell Presbyterian Church to our church. This request was approved by the Session.
- 2. Finance Committee Chairperson Roland Neumann reported that the market value of the church's investments is \$361,658.11. Treasurer Wayne Sauer will be transferring \$6,000 from our investments to the General Budget.
- 3. Stewardship/Church Growth Committee Chairperson Edith Keck reported that Stewardship Sunday will be on November 12; pledges will be received. The Stewardship letter has been mailed out to members.
- 4. Christian Education Committee Chairperson Mary Jane Gardner reported that Christian Education Coordinator Beth Murphy will be consulting with Jerry Conklin on how to involve the Sunday School students in Christmas services.
- 5. Worship Committee Chairpersons Phyllis Menzenski and Judy Brandow assigned Communion servers for November and December. There was discussion of Christmas Eve services, since December 24 falls on a Sunday this year. The Sunday morning service will be at the usual time, and there will be one service on Christmas Eve. It is hoped that we can have the traditional pageant, but volunteers will be needed in order for this to be possible.



Harvest Buffet





Cpl. Jonathan Wolf of the U.S. Marines from Pleasant Valley recently finished a tour in Australia.

His mother and father, Roxanne Wolf and Tom Falciano, said his photo, waving at the camera as he waited in line to board a plane, was used on the front page of a newspaper in Australia.

The photo depicts the latest contingent of Marines waiting to board a flight leaving the Northern Territory after a rotation there. It was the first time the Marines took part in a combined training with Australian forces on responding to natural disasters.

Approximately 300 marines flew out of Darwin's RAAF base, the first of the 1,250-strong contingent to depart after six months in the Top End.

Wolf and his fellow Marines' departure marked the end of the sixth rotation of American troops to the Northern Territory that was part of a 2011 agreement as part of a U.S. military "pivot" to the Asia-Pacific region, according to his parents.

Wolf is stationed at 29 Palms, California, said Roxanne Wolf.
