One Sunday morning I was jolted out of my morning reverie by the piercing noise of a fire alarm. With my heart beating a heavy cadence in my chest, and the discordant sound still blaring in my ears, I ran from room to room checking for signs of a fire; thankfully there were none. As it was quite dark in my inner rooms I lit wood wick candles and the crackling sound of the flame echoed in my ears. Finishing my morning devotionals I readied myself to face the world.

Enjoying the silence I began to notice the little sounds that accompany our daily lives: the sound of water rising to the top of a glass, the gliding sound of apparel as it rests into position, the soft noise that is made when toothpaste is applied to a toothbrush, the swish of my skirt as I step through the doorway. I could almost hear God whispering in the quiet.

As I stepped out into my community there was total silence. Because it was early in the morning nothing was moving. No sounds came from any of the residences. No engines were being turned over in the cars. Even the morning doves were quiet. The silence felt almost holy. I found myself thinking, not about the fact that my hair was wet, or that fewer people might be in church because they had no power, but that the church might be able to experience this silence too...this quiet reverent silence. I could envision Alta at the piano, the quiet beauty of the sanctuary without electric lights, and the reverent hush of the congregation as they too experienced this rare moment from God. I was actually excited at the prospect.

Inserting the key into the ignition of the car the engine broke the silence and the radio jarringly sprang into life. I quickly hit the off button. As I began the descent of the hill on West Road work crews filled my vision and my hope that the church and I could share this rare moment of quiet abruptly ended. For a moment I was saddened, but life goes on...

Our lives are filled with these brief but wonderful moments. Each may be seen as a gift from God. If we open ourselves to the Creator these tiny moments, these wonderful gifts can fill our lives ... even in the most mundane of days.

The Holy may be found in many circumstances. I wish you many quiet moments with God.



For those who purchased the new church tee shirt, they will be available at coffee hour on September 10. See you at the parade!




